Statement: "So, we have been told we are going to be killed. And we are walking. And people are coming and one guy looks at me and he says, 'Call me.' So, I am like, 'Come' ... And the security people have said, 'Please don't do this ... please don't call people, because it is putting everyone at risk.' So, he comes and he starts walking next to me. So he says, 'Mr Gandhi, you have come here to listen to us.' I am like, 'yes'.

He said, 'That is interesting.' He is like, 'You really come here to listen to us.' I am like, 'yes' and he is like good. And then he says, 'You see those guys over there?' And we are walking. I ask, 'Who?' He says, 'Those boys over there.' He is like, 'They are militants.' Now militants should normally kill me ... In that environment, militants should kill me.

He said they are there and they are looking at you. So, I look at them and they are giving me this sort of look and I am like, okay, I am now in trouble because this guy has just told me this ... They give me this look and I give them this look back and then we carry on. Nothing happens.

Why I am telling you this is because they actually couldn't do anything. They actually didn't have the power to do anything even if they wanted to. Because I had come into that environment listening. And I had come into that environment completely with no violence in me at all. And a vast number of people were saying that. That to me was an indicator of listening and non-violence."
