## 21 key controversies: Exposing Sonam Wangchuk and His deep ties with Ford And Rockfeller Foundation, among others

This report compiles **21 key controversies** surrounding **Sonam Wangchuk**, including his links to **anti-India organisations**.

On **26 September 2025**, activist Sonam Wangchuk was been **arrested by the Leh police under NSA**. He was accused of **inciting a mob with provocative statements**. On September 25, the MHA also cancelled the registration of Wangchuk's non-profit organization, "Students Educational and Cultural Movement of Ladakh (SECMOL)", for violating the FCRA Act, 2010.

#### In 2007 UPA Accused Sonam Wangchuk of FCRA 4. Misuse, Illegal Land, and Anti-National Links

Date: 28 February 2007

In 2007, the UPA government accused Sonam Wangchuk of:

- Misusing funds received under the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA)
- Illegally occupying 200 kanals of land without paying dues
- Having alleged anti-national links with China and other foreign entities
- Attempting to disturb the social harmony of Ladakh

#### 5. Ladakh Administration Revokes Land Allotted to Sonam Wangchuk's HIAL Over Non-Utilisation

**Date**: 21 August 2025

The Ladakh administration revoked the land allotted to Sonam Wangchuk's Himalayan Institute of Alternative Learning (HIAL) in the Union Territory.

In 2018, around 1,076 kanals of land in Phywang village, Leh, had been granted to HIAL on a 40-year lease. However, Deputy Commissioner Leh, Romil Singh Donk, cancelled the allotment, stating that the land was not utilised for its intended purpose, as no legally recognised university had been established on the site to date.

### 8. Sonam Wangchuk terms anti-India Dan Church Aid, a 'reputed organisation'

**Date**: 26 August 2023

Alleging MHA leaking his NGO's details, Sonam Wangchuk terms Dan Church Aid, a 'reputed organisation', Dan Church Aid is funded by George Soros.

On 26 August 2023, the Karnataka High Court dismissed a writ petition filed by Bengaluru-based MANSA Centre for Development and Social Action, which had sought a directive to its bank to release ₹29.12 lakh received from Denmark-based NGO Dan Church Aid that had been withheld.

The Court noted that, following a 2013 communication from the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) had instructed all banks to ensure that any fund transfers from Dan Church Aid to individuals or organisations in India must be reported to the ministry for clearance before being processed.


### Sonam Wangchuk Comes from Influential Family, Not Poor Background (as Portrayed in 3 idiots)

Sonam Wangchuk married an American woman, Rebecca Norman, in 1996. Rebecca studied at the School for International Training (SIT) and Harvard University. SIT, a private non-profit institution based in Brattleboro, USA, is closely associated with the U.S. State Department and receives funding from the Ford Foundation, George Soros' Open Society Foundations (OSF), and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. Rebecca is also a strong supporter of Joe Biden and a vocal critic of Donald Trump.

Sonam Wangchuk founded the Students' Educational and Cultural Movement of Ladakh (SECMOL) in 1988. The organisation receives funding from FutureEarth Networks, whose founder, Paul Shrivastava, now serves as Co-President of The Club of Rome — a prominent think tank established with Rockefeller support. The Club of Rome is widely known for initiating the global discourse on "climate crisis" and "overpopulation" through its influential 1971 report titled Limits of Growth.

### 14. Wangchuk Received 2002 Ashoka Fellowship Funded by Rockfeller

In 2002, Sonam Wangchuk received Ashoka fellowship which is funded by Skoll foundation, Schwab foundation, Rockefeller foundation

# 15. Sonam Wangchuk Appointed to Ladakh Vision and National Education Councils During Manmohan Singh's Tenure

In 2004, when Manmohan Singh became the Prime Minister of India, Sonam Wangchuk was appointed to the Drafting Committee of the Ladakh Hill Council Vision Document, Ladakh 2025, and was tasked with formulating policies on education and tourism. The document was formally launched by Manmohan Singh in 2005. In the same year, Wangchuk was also appointed as a member of the National Governing Council for Elementary Education under the Ministry of Human Resource Development in the Manmohan Singh government.

the launch of Operation New Hope in 1994, a collaboration to bring reforms in the government school system. He completed his bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering from NTI, Srinagar. In 2001, he was appointed as an advisor for the education in the Hill Council Government. In 2002, together with other NGO heads, he founded Ladakh Voluntary Network (LVN), a network of Ladakh NGOs, and served in its Executive committee as the Secretary till 2005. In 2004, he was appointed to the Drafting Committee of the Ladakh Hill Council Government's Vision Document Ladakh 2025' and he was entrusted with the formulation of the policy on Education and Tourism. The document was formally launched by Dr. Mannnohan Singh, the Prime Minister of India in 2005. In 2005, he was also appointed as a member in the National Governing Council for Elementary Education in the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.

#### 16. Sonam Wangchuk's Connections with Ford Foundation and Other International NGOs

In 2016, he <u>received</u> the Fred M. Packard Award from the Switzerland-based International Union for Conservation of Nature, an award funded by organizations including the Rockefeller, Pew, and Packard Foundations.



In 2017, he was awarded the TN Khoshoo Memorial Award, which is also funded by the Ford Foundation.



#### T N Khoshoo Memorial Award and Lecture

The T.N.Khoshoo Memorial Award and Lecture was instituted in 2004 to hanour the legacy of the world-renowned environmental scientist, Dr Triloid Nath Khoshoo, Dr Khoshoo was first Secretary of the Indian Government's newly created Department of Environment, in 1982. He played a significant role in the development of India's environmental policy, Dr Khoshoo was one of the original trustees of ATREE.

The annual TN Khoshoo Memorial Award is given to an academician or a practitioner whose work has had an impact in the fields of environment, conservation, or development. The TN Khoshoo Memorial Award was started by the Khoshoo family and ATREE to hanour Dr Khoshoo's legacy. Through the TN Khoshoo Endowment Fund, the award, each year, encourages and promotes individuals for outstanding achievements in the field of conservation and sustainable development. The fund is spansared by Dr Khoshoo's family, ATREE, the Ford Foundation, the Institute of Rural Research and Development (an initiative of the SM Sebaal Foundation,) and other philanthropists. The award consists of a cash price of Rs 100,000.

- In 2018, he received his most prominent recognition, the Magsaysay Award, an honor often linked to individuals with connections to international networks, including those associated with the CIA, which has historical links to the Ford Foundation. [The Better India]
- Sonam is affiliated with the NGO LEAD India, another organization funded by the Ford Foundation and Rockefeller Foundation . [Ford foundation] [Lead india about]
- He is also <u>involved</u> with the International Association for Ladakh Studies, which published a four-volume work on Ladakh's culture, a project supported by the Ford Foundation.
